

4.1 The management and control of the Trust and the properties of the Trust shall vest in the board of Trustees. The board of trustees shall comprise not less than five and not more than nine trustees including the settlers.

5.0 RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE TRUST:

5.1 The settler-cum- Managing Trustee Sri D.Murali Krishna and Secretary Sri Gunnam Bhaskar Rao as mentioned shall hold their office for life time, and the office of managing trustee & Secretary shall be hereditary.

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- 5.10 The Managing trustee of the Trust can apply for lease to the concerned authority for acquiring required quantity of land/building for the purpose of the trust.
- 5.11 Meeting by requisition : Any Trustee may request the Managing Trustee to convene a meeting by requisition in writing specifying the object for which the meeting is desired to be convened. If the managing trustee does not hold a meeting within a fortnight from the date of service of requisition, such trustee may convene the meeting at the office of the Trust after giving not less than 15days notice to the Trustee, but no business other than the specified in the requisition will be transacted in such meeting.
- 5.12 Decision by voting : All maters arising to deal with at the meeting shall be decided by majority of votes. provided however, that if, the matter relates to the sale of any property, movable/immovable, belonging to the trustee or to making of changing an investment, the same shall not be decided except by majority of at least 2/3 members of Trustees attending and voting at the meeting.
- 5.13 In all cases of transfer of property of the trust the deed of agreement shall be signed and sealed by the Managing Trustee & Secretary other wise, it shall be deemed as null & void.
- 5.14 Circulated resolution : A resolution in writing circulated among all the Trustees and signed by all of them present in India shall be valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of the Trustees duly called and convened.
- 5.15 All meetings of the Trustees shall be held at such place as the Trustees may from time to time decide. A Trustee, who is unable to be present at a meeting of the Trustees, may send his views on the agenda in writing, and such expression of opinion shall be taken to be his views on the matters concerned. 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5.18 The Annual income and expenditure of the Trust shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and the audit report should be placed for consideration and action as may be necessary in annual meeting.

5.19 To appoint attorneys, agents etc, to nominate, constitute, and appoint constituted attorney or agent and to delegate to such attorney or agent or so far as it permissible under law, powers with regard to Management of the Trust fund all matters and affairs relating thereto for the purpose of carrying out the objects and purposes thereof or for the collection and profit of the trust fund or any part thereof or to operate any account with a bank and to conduct appear in or defend any cause of action on behalf of the trust before any civil, criminal, revenue, tax or other authorities, courts, offices, Tribunals, Forums etc without being responsible for the default of such attorney or agent.

5.20 The trustees shall not be entitled to any remuneration for their services, but shall be entitled to traveling and other wise settle any debt, account claim or dispute whatever relating to the Trust fund or any part thereof.

5.21 To compromise, compound, abandon, submit, to arbitration or otherwise settle any debt, account claim or dispute whosoever relating to the trust fund or any part thereof.

5.22 The trustees can frame other rules and regulations for fulfillment of the aims and objects and for the smooth management of the Trust.

5.23 Any of these rules and regulations can be amended by at least 2/3rd of the total no. of trustees.

5.24 The Trust shall have an official seal, individual seals of the Managing Trustee, Secretary, treasurer and other seals, if required. The seals will be kept under the custody of the Managing Trustee/Secretary.
